

3. Due Diligence Checklist for International Investing

Before investing your hard-earned money, ask yourself these critical questions. This is not financial advice, but a framework to guide your personal research.

☐ Market-Level Analysis (The Big Picture)

- What are the current geopolitical conditions related to North Korea? (Check recent news from reputable sources like Reuters or the Associated Press).
- What are the latest GDP growth forecasts for South Korea from institutions like the IMF or OECD?
- How has the South Korean Won (**KRW**) performed against the US Dollar (**USD**) over the last year? A strengthening Won is a tailwind; a weakening Won is a headwind.

☐ ETF-Specific Analysis (Know What You're Buying)

- Expense Ratio: What is the annual fee for this ETF? Is there a comparable ETF with a lower fee?
- **Top Holdings:** What are the top 10 companies in the fund, and what percentage do they represent? Am I comfortable with this level of concentration (e.g., Samsung's ~23%
- eight in)?
- **Liquidity:** What is the average daily trading volume? (Higher volume means it's easier to buy and sell at a fair price).
- **Dividend Yield:** Does the ETF pay a dividend? If so, how much and how often?

□ Personal Portfolio Analysis (How It Fits Your Goals)

- What percentage of my total investment portfolio will this single-country ETF represent? (Financial planners often suggest limiting single-country exposure to a small portion, e.g., under 5% of your total portfolio, especially for beginners).
- Does this investment align with my long-term financial goals (e.g., aggressive growth,

diversification)?

• What is my exit strategy? Under what conditions would I sell this investment?

4. Glossary of Key Terms

- Chaebol (재벌): A large, family-controlled industrial conglomerate unique to South Korea. Examples include Samsung, Hyundai, and LG. Understanding their influence is key to understanding the Korean economy.
- KOSPI (Korea Composite Stock Price Index): The main stock market index of South Korea, representing all common stocks traded on the Korea Exchange. It's the South Korean equivalent of the S&P 500.
- **Expense Ratio:** The annual percentage of a fund's assets that is charged to cover its operating expenses. A lower expense ratio is generally better for the investor.
- Currency Risk (Exchange-Rate Risk): The risk that your investment's value will decrease simply because the value of the foreign currency (KRW) falls relative to your home currency (USD).
