## Pre-Installation Checklist

• Measure Everything: Don't just measure the cutout. Measure your doorways, hallways, and any tight corners the delivery team will need to navigate.

- Check the Floor: Ensure the floor where the refrigerator will sit is level. If not, be prepared to adjust the leveling feet during installation.
- Water Line Access: The ice maker requires a cold water line with a shut-off valve. Ensure it is accessible and within 6 feet of the refrigerator's location. Use a new stainless steel braided hose for installation.
- Electrical Requirements: This model requires a dedicated 115V, 60Hz, 15-20 amp grounded electrical outlet. Do not use an extension cord.

### Long-Term Maintenance Schedule
